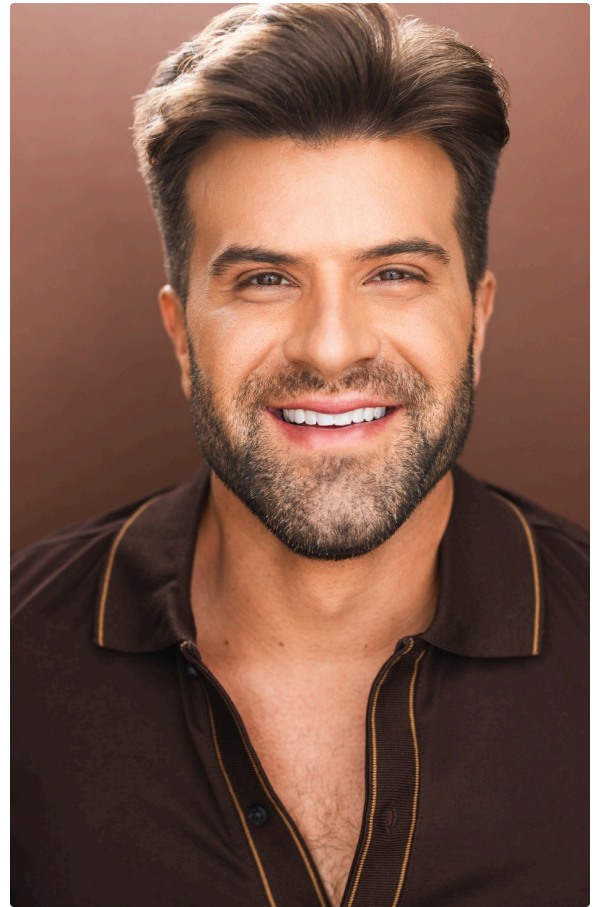
Danny Drewes
